

Hawman-Collier Scholarship Fund

Purpose: This fund was established to provide scholarships to graduating seniors of the King City High School pursuing a degree in the medical field.

Criteria: In order to be eligible for the scholarship, you must meet the following:

The students eligible for assistance shall be graduating seniors intending to continue their education through a two or four year college/university and/or technical school.

Students must be pursuing a degree in the medical field including medical doctors, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, medical technologists and physical therapists. Medical administration is **not** an acceptable field of study.

First priority is given to graduating seniors but if there are no qualified applicants, it will be made available to past graduates of King City High School.

Submit a scholarship application.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and disbursed in August.

Amount: Two scholarships of up to \$750 will be awarded. The amount is based on the earnings of the fund.

Deadline: March 1
